Vendor Guidelines

1. **Vendor application forms must be completed and payment received by Friday, May 1, 2009**
2. The registration fee is \$75/single (approx 12' x 12' space) or \$135/double (approx 24' x 12' space) for non-food vendors and \$100/single or \$175/double-space for food vendors, due with your application to reserve your space. Vendor fees are non-refundable once space has been approved and assigned.
3. Upon receipt of the registration forms, the Festival Committee will assign spaces in the appropriate area. Space assignments are at the sole discretion of the festival management.
4. Porn items, drug related items, weapons, items that may be promoting drugs, alcohol, weapons, or tobacco, or sexually suggestive items are not permitted for sale. The Pend Oreille Valley Bluegrass Festival management reserves the right to ask you to remove any questionable or prohibited items.
5. Vendors may begin set-up at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 10th. Food vendors will be required to serve meals from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, and on Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. If serving breakfast, vendors must be open and ready to serve by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
6. There will be electricity and water available only for the food vendors.
7. Vendors will be responsible for their own personal property during the hours of operation. There will be minimal overnight security provided by the festival.
8. Vendors must not begin removal of their exhibits until 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 13th.
9. All vendors must have proper licenses and permits, and liability insurance.
10. Your booth must remain clean and attractive.
11. Vendors must sign and include liability disclaimer (below) with application.
